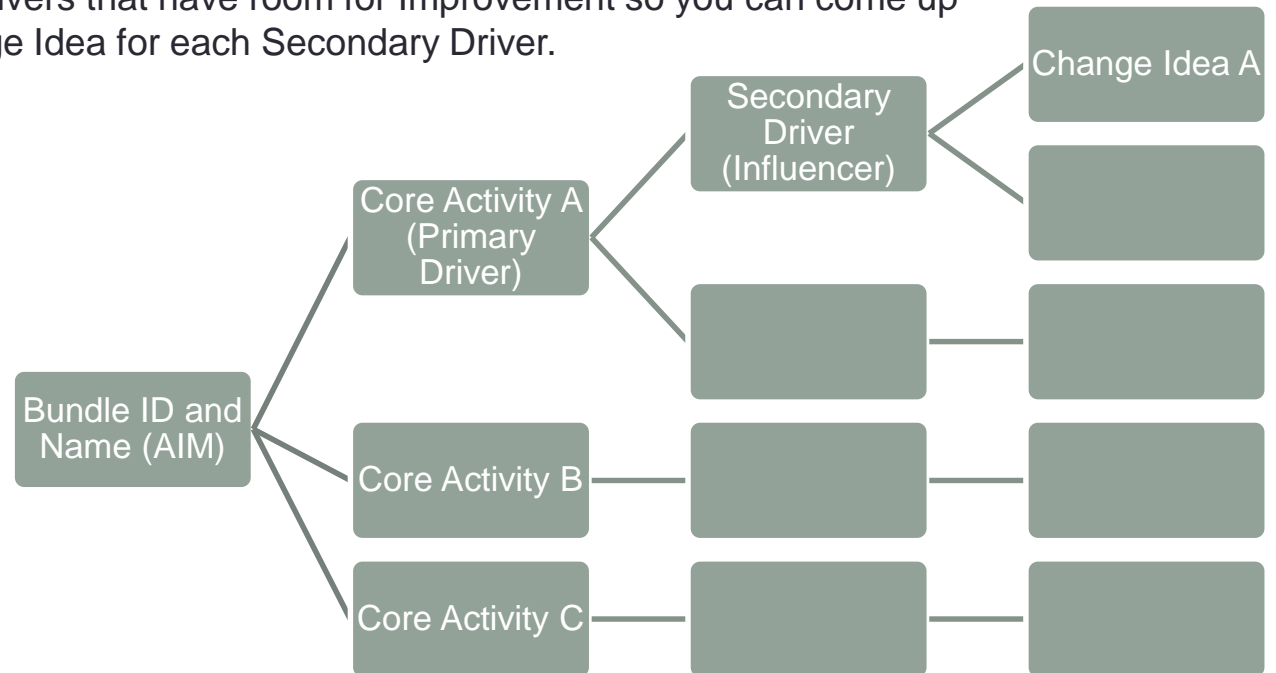
- The second round of FAQ on the Measure Specifications has been posted on the DSRIP Online Reporting System bulletin board.

- The RHP plan will be posted online for public feedback. The date of this is TBD.

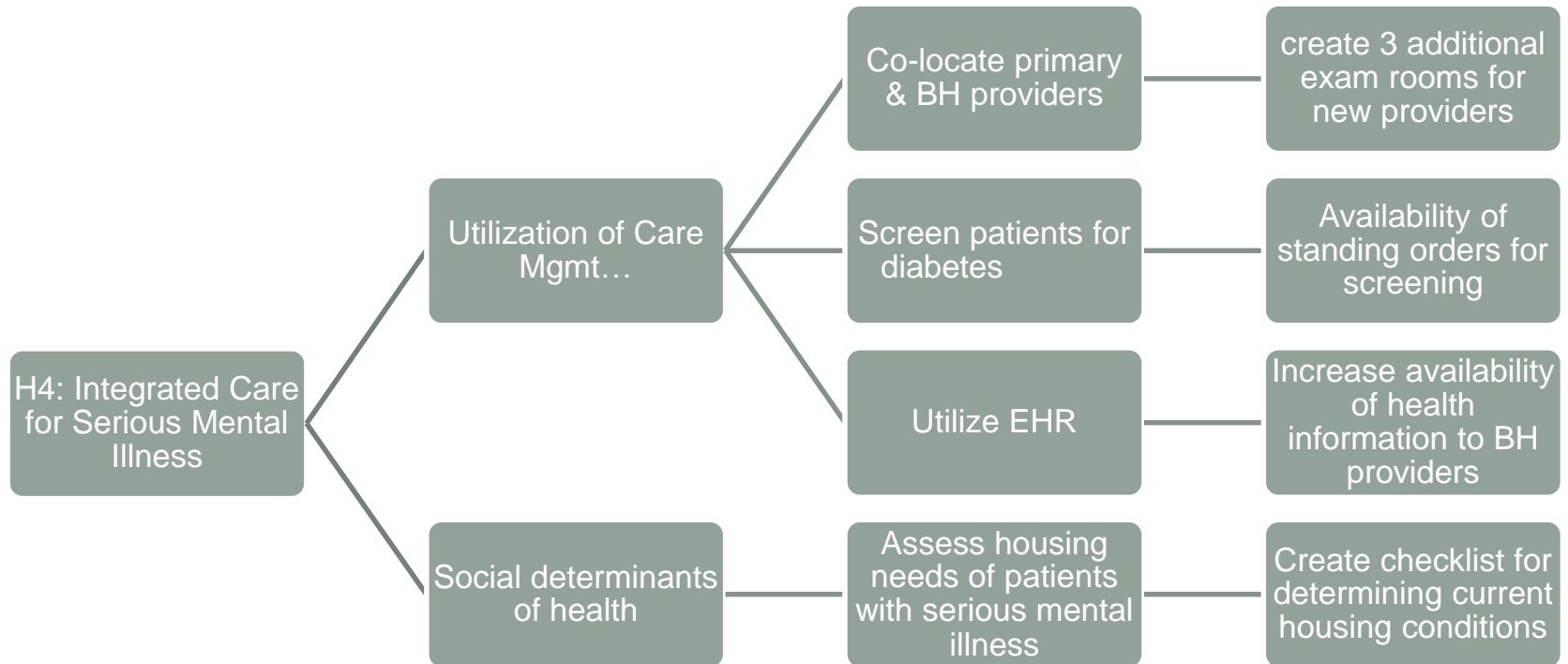
Bundle Driver Diagram Instructions

6. Select Secondary Drivers that have room for Improvement so you can come up with at least 1 Change Idea for each Secondary Driver.

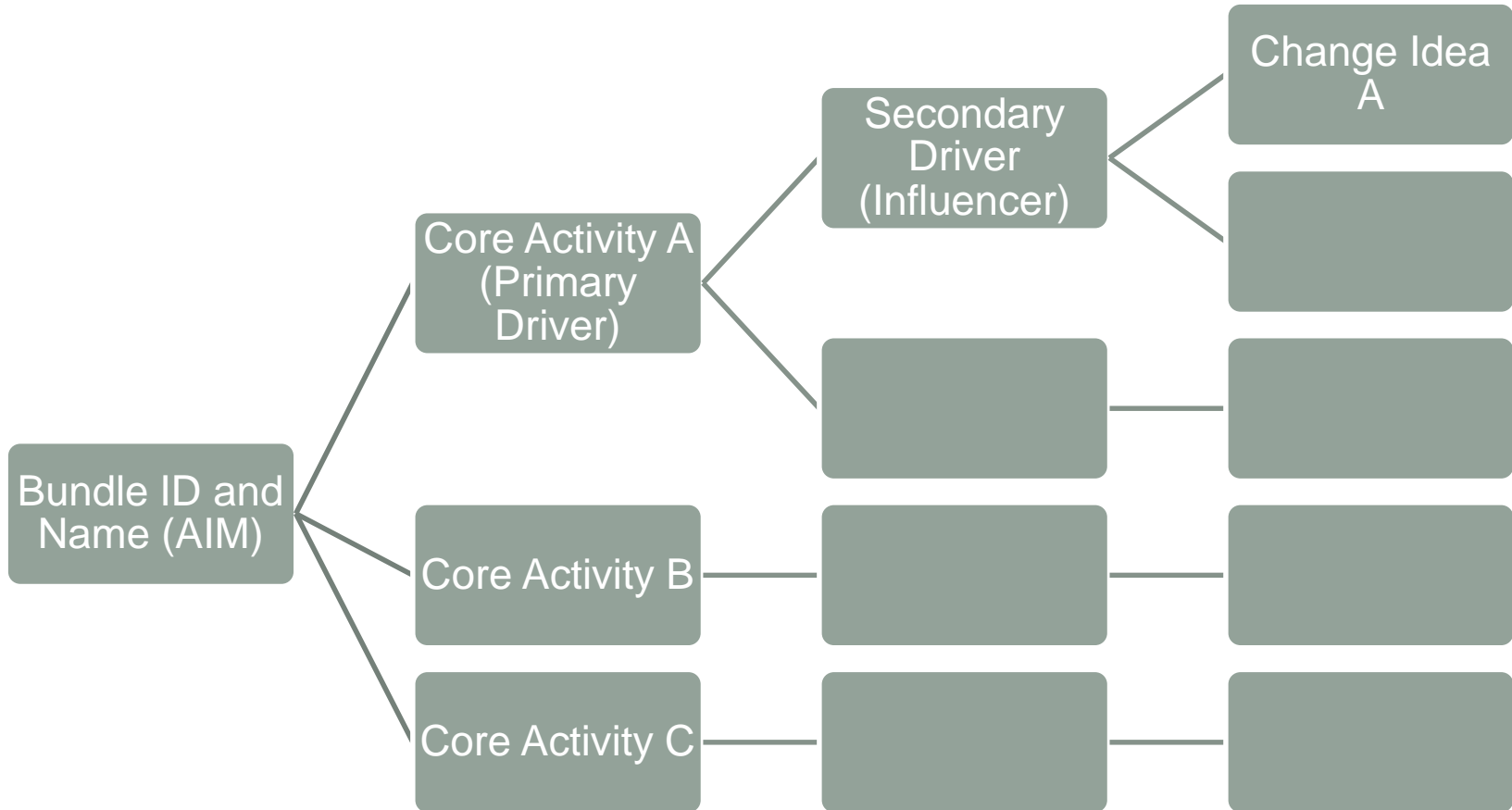


H4: Integrated Care for Serious Mental Illness
